Please use this questionnaire to provide us with as much information as possible about your travel plans. Please ensure that you tell us all the places you are planning on going to on your holiday and not just the country. This allows the Practice nurse to ensure that you are given the right amount of time for your travel appointment to ensure that all relevant topics are discussed.

It is the responsibility of you, the traveller, to ring back 1 week after completing this form to book your appointment.

Ideally travel vaccinations should be given 4-6 weeks before travel. If a holiday is booked last minute and no appointments are available please be aware that it is not the responsibility of the surgery to give you an urgent travel clinic appointment.

Travel vaccinations

Not all vaccinations (travel injections) are free; some need to be paid for in advance or on the day when the vaccination is given. A list of the most common vaccinations is below. Please note these can only be paid for by cash or a cheque. We request that vaccinations are paid for before they are given by the nurse.

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Polio - no charge
- Typhoid - no charge
- Hepatitis A - no charge
- Cholera - no charge
- Hepatitis B - £85 (course of 3)
- Yellow Fever - £50 (£75 for non-registered patients)
- Rabies - £170 (course of 3)

Malaria tablets

Some countries have a risk of malaria. The nurse will inform you at your travel appointment if anti-malaria medication is required. Please be aware that the cost of anti-malaria medication varies from chemist to chemist, and some anti-malaria medications require a private prescription. Private prescriptions incur an additional charge of £5, payable to the surgery.
