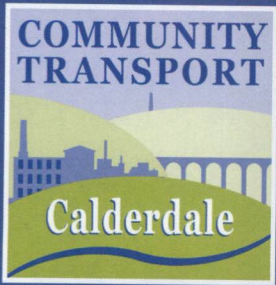

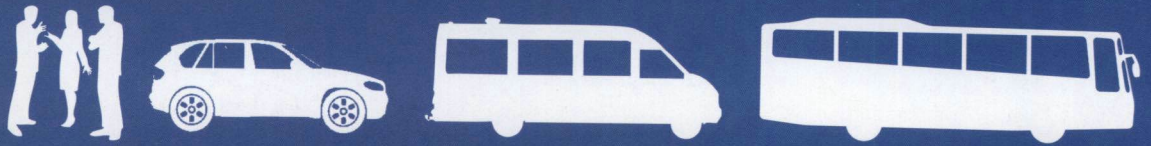

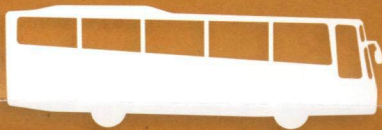
TWO

The Community Car Service operates throughout Calderdale, purely with volunteer drivers who only charge their volunteer expenses to the passenger. A membership fee is required to join the car scheme. The driver would normally wait a reasonable length of time at appointments.



THREE

Group and Accessible Minibus Service is available for groups and individuals. The fleet ranges from people carriers to 16 passenger seat minibuses, all with wheelchair access. Available with a driver or for self-drive. All drivers must be MIDAS trained. A membership fee is required.



FOUR

Community Bus Service is a series of timetabled registered bus routes in Calderdale, operated on a not for profit basis in communities who have lost existing bus services. These services are registered with the concessionary fare scheme operated by Metro and are for public use.
